WHAT IS MURDER MYSTERY?

Murder Mystery is a fully immersive evening experience built around a formal dinner where nothing is quite as it seems.

Guests take on characters, gather clues, question the other guests, and try to work out who among them committed the crime - all before the inspector delivers the final reveal.

The mystery can unfold across a formal dinner, course by course, with new evidence revealed between each one. Or it can take over an entire building, with groups moving between floors and rooms as the story plays out around them. From arrival to reveal it runs between two and a half and four hours, depending on the format you choose.



WHY CHOOSE A MURDER MYSTERY?

Everyone Has a Role

Six suspects drawn from your group are given character packs, secrets, and scripted dialogue. Every other guest is a detective - questioning suspects, reviewing evidence, and building a case. Nobody watches from the sidelines.

The Killer Doesn't Know They Did It

Characters are written so that even the person playing the killer doesn't know they are guilty until the reveal. Everyone plays along genuinely. The paranoia builds naturally.

Premium Production

Character packs are printed on premium card stock and delivered in wax-sealed envelopes. The room is dressed to theme before guests arrive. Every detail is considered. This is not a game - it is an occasion.

Fully Facilitated

Your inspector runs the entire evening. Guests need no preparation beyond their costume. Everything else is handled from arrival to reveal.



THE THEMES

We offer four distinct themes with various storylines within each. Each runs across all formats and uses the same pricing.



Classic 1920s English country house. Think Agatha Christie meets Downton Abbey - old money, old secrets, and a body before the first course arrives. Candlelit, atmospheric, wax-sealed.

Costume brief: 1920s formal. Suits, pearls, drop-waist dresses.



1920s Chicago. Prohibition is in full swing, organised crime runs the city, and someone at the table won't be leaving. Kraft envelopes, black wax seals, speakeasy atmosphere.

Costume brief: 1920s mob. Pinstripe suits, fedoras, flapper dresses.



A black tie evening with a classified agenda. Dossiers have been distributed, a mission has gone wrong, and someone in the room is not who they claim to be.

Costume brief: black tie or 1960s spy chic. Smart formal works perfectly.



1980s holiday resort. A poolside paradise where the cocktails are strong, the fancy dress is mandatory, and someone at the bar won't be checking out.

Costume brief: 1980s resort wear. Hawaiian shirts, sundresses, sunglasses.

THE FORMATS

Each theme is available in three formats. The right choice depends on what you want from the evening and your budget. All three include premium production materials, room dressing to theme, and full facilitation from arrival to reveal.

THE CLASSIC

Our most popular format. Two professional hosts run the evening - an inspector who commands the room and a butler who manages arrivals and the flow of the night. Six willing volunteers from your group are assigned suspect characters in advance. They receive their character and script before the event, arrive ready to play their role, and read their lines from premium character cards at the table. The rest of your guests are the detective audience - asking pre-scripted questions, reviewing evidence, and building their case across the courses.

What's included:

- Professional inspector and butler hosts in costume
- Six guest suspect roles with full wax-sealed character packs
- Premium printed materials throughout
- Room dressed to theme on arrival
- Three rounds of evidence and questioning across the courses
- Full reveal and close

THE CAST

The same format and script as The Classic, but the six suspect roles are played by professional actors sitting amongst your guests at the dinner table. They are fully off-book, in character, and indistinguishable from the rest of the group until the reveal. Your guests still ask the questions and solve the case.

Works particularly well for larger groups where voice projection across the room matters, or for clients who want a more polished, seamless experience without guests having to recite lines.

What's included:

- Professional inspector and butler hosts in costume
- Six professional actors in suspect roles
- All actors in full costume
- Premium wax-sealed production materials throughout
- Room dressed to theme on arrival
- Three rounds of evidence and questioning
- Full reveal and close

THE PRODUCTION

A step up in production. Professional actors perform fully scripted scenes throughout the evening - confrontations, revelations, and dramatic moments that unfold around your guests as they dine. This is a fully produced show where the story happens in the room with you. Guests still question the cast, gather evidence, and submit their accusations - but the performances are delivered by professionals who have rehearsed in the space before you arrive. Also available as a multi-room format across the whole venue if the building is suitable.

What's included:

- Five professional actors plus a stage manager/director
- All actors fully costumed and in character from arrival
- Scripted scene moments performed live throughout the evening
- Premium wax-sealed production materials throughout
- Room dressed to theme on arrival
- Full reveal and close

HOW IT WORKS



1

ARRIVAL AND DRINKS

Guests arrive to a room already dressed to theme. Candelabras lit, envelopes sealed, everything in place before the first guest walks in. The atmosphere does the work before a word is spoken.

2

CHARACTER PACKS DISTRIBUTED

Each guest receives a sealed wax-stamped envelope. Inside - their character name, their backstory, and their first secret. The mystery hasn't started. But the suspicion has.

3

THE CRIME IS ANNOUNCED

The inspector takes the floor. A crime has been committed. The suspects are introduced. From this moment, nobody is quite who they seem.

4

ROUND ONE

The first round of evidence is revealed. Suspects deliver their opening statements. Detectives ask their first questions. A sealed envelope at each table contains new information.

5

ROUND TWO

New evidence emerges. A revelation changes everything. Another envelope. Another secret. The accusations start to fly.

6

ROUND THREE AND ACCUSATIONS

The final round of evidence. The inspector calls for accusations. Every guest writes their answer and seals it. The tension in the room is real.

7

THE REVEAL

Wrong answers first. The drama builds. Then - the truth. The killer stands. The alibis unravel. Everything makes sense, and nothing will quite look the same over dessert.

The flow of the evening adapts to your group size, venue, and format. In our multi-room experiences, guests move between spaces rather than remaining seated, and the structure shifts accordingly. This gives you a flavour of how a night with us runs - your inspector or stage manager will tailor the pace and format to make it work perfectly for your group.
